This partnership will open doors for knowledge exchange and academic advancement across diverse disciplines such as Agriculture, Pharmacy, Management, and more.

A New Milestone for Gurukul!

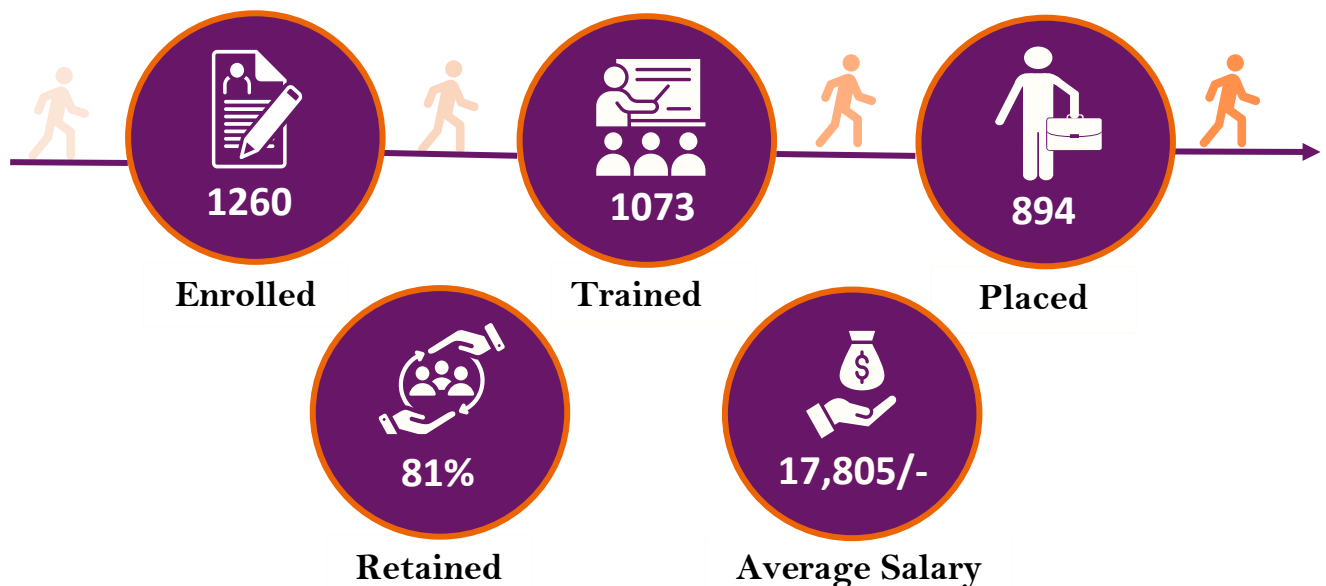


On 30th April 2025, an official Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI and K.M. University, a UGC-approved private university established in 2023 in Mathura, offering a wide range of undergraduate, postgraduate, diploma, and research programs across streams such as Agriculture, Pharmacy, Polytechnic, Medical, Management, Commerce, and more. The MoU was formally signed by Dr. Pooran Singh (Registrar, KM University)

and Mr. Ram Mohan Lawaniyan (In-Charge, Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI) in the presence of Deans and Heads of all major departments of KM University. Ram Mohan Sir, emphasized the ongoing community work being led by Krishnashray Gurukul and the future scope of collaboration with KM University — including joint efforts in career counseling, internships, medical camps, higher education access, and agricultural initiatives. This MoU aims to create long-term, meaningful change for the youth of Braj region, by combining academic excellence with ground-level community engagement.



PROGRESS UNDER AU IGNITE PROGRAM



PROGRESS UNDER BETTER WHEAT INITIATIVE

Soil Health Improvement Program | 23 May 2025



We are actively organizing community meetings and conducting awareness campaigns across various locations and among diverse farmer groups. Our primary areas of focus include:

1. Farmer Engagement & Interactive Sessions
2. Soil Sample Collection Methods
3. Education on Soil Testing



These initiatives aim to empower farmers with the knowledge and tools needed to make informed decisions for long-term soil and crop health.

Exposure Visit | 25 May 2025



As part of our ongoing efforts to enhance the Agriculture Training Program and develop a Model Farm, two insightful exposure visits were conducted. **The first visit was to KVK Kumher**, where **Dr. Navab Singh (Senior Scientist & Head)** shared valuable expertise on seasonal cropping patterns, protected cultivation through green nets and poly houses, and efficient water use via drip and sprinkler micro irrigation systems. Additionally, practical knowledge was gained on setting up vermicompost units using different earthworms, azolla cultivation for livestock feed and bio-fertilizer, and beekeeping operations including honey extraction and marketing. Discussions on farm layout, necessary tools, equipment, and demonstration areas provided strategic direction for infrastructure planning. **The second visit to Aasara Organic Farm in Naugawan, hosted by Mr. Rahul Sharma**, focused on organic and natural farming methods, soil health management, and pest control using bio-inputs. The concept of multilayer farming and intercropping in guava orchards was explored for better land utilization and economic returns. The team also observed a solar drying unit for turmeric and fenugreek and learned about efficient post-harvest processing techniques. These visits provided critical insights for integrating sustainable and practical farming practices into the upcoming training curriculum and model farm design.

Agriculture Expert Visit | 31 May 2025

As part of the Better Wheat Initiative, a farmer meeting was organized in Sakarwa Village, attracting active participation from local farmers. The session was led by agricultural experts **Shri Mukesh Kumawat (Agriculture Development Officer – Agriculture)**, **Shri Manoj Yadav (Agriculture Development Officer – Plant Protection)**. The purpose of the visit was to educate farmers on modern and sustainable agricultural practices to enhance farm productivity. The experts addressed several key topics, including:

- Integrated Nutrient Management (INM)
- Integrated Pest Management (IPM)
- Micro-Irrigation Techniques
- Soil Health Improvement
- Soil Sample Collection for Analysis
- Bio-Waste Management
- Green Manuring & Organic Carbon Enrichment



Farmers were encouraged to adopt these techniques to improve crop health, reduce input costs, and boost long-term soil fertility. The interactive session provided an open platform for farmers to share concerns, ask questions, and receive on-the-spot guidance. Such initiatives play a vital role in empowering the farming community with the latest knowledge and tools, ensuring sustainable agricultural development and increased profitability.

Viksit Krishi Sankalp Yatra | 8 Jun 2025



As part of the nationwide "**Viksit Krishi Sankalp Yatra**", farmers from Sakarwa Village actively took part in the awareness campaign aimed at promoting sustainable agriculture and modern farming practices. Over 30 farmers from the village enthusiastically joined the event. The participants were sensitized on various government schemes related to agriculture and subsidies, benefits of adopting natural and organic farming methods, scientific approaches to Integrated Nutrient Management (INM) and Integrated Pest

Management (IPM) and water conservation techniques and measures to improve soil health. The program was facilitated by subject experts including **Dr. Barij Bhushan (Horticulture Expert, KVK)**, **Dr. Rakesh Kumar (Animal Husbandry Expert, CIRG)**, Agriculture Officers: **Mr. Mukesh Kumawat and Mr. Manoj Yadav** and Gram Pradhan: **Shri Niranjana Saini**. The event significantly enhanced awareness among local farmers, motivated them towards adopting sustainable and innovative farming practices, and fostered stronger linkages with agricultural institutions. Farmers showed keen interest in further capacity-building and technical support.

“FROM PASSION TO PURPOSE: REDEFINING BEAUTY” — ANJALI VERMA



I never planned to become a trainer or work in the development sector, but my journey which began with casual visits turned into something far more meaningful. My name is Anjali Verma, and I come from Mathura. I completed B.Com in 2014, unsure of which path to take after college. During my graduation, I stayed with my aunt in Jaipur, who owned a salon. I visited her daily, initially just helping out and observing the work. Over time, I developed a genuine interest in beauty and wellness. I enjoyed the creativity and the transformations we brought to clients. Gradually, I began supporting my aunt more actively—training new staff and managing the salon. This hands-on experience became my informal foundation in the field. In 2020, I returned to Mathura for my sister’s wedding, thinking I’d soon go back to Jaipur, where I had been helping my aunt run her salon. But destiny had other plans. The COVID-19 lockdown changed everything—work stopped, travel was restricted, and life became uncertain. I thought I might return during the peak salon season when income was better, but when God has a plan, our own plans often don’t matter.

One day, Arpita Ma’am, who knows my aunt, informed me about a vacancy for an Assistant Beautician Trainer at Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI in Goverdhan. She shared my contact with Poonam Ma’am, who called and invited me to visit the center before making a decision. My father was initially hesitant due to the unfamiliar location, but after much convincing, he agreed to accompany me. That visit changed everything. The moment I entered Gurukul, I felt an instant connection. The environment made me realize that I could do this—not just as a job, but as a mission. Having trained salon staff before, I was confident in my ability to guide others. This opportunity felt like a meaningful way to empower young women using the same skills that empowered me. I joined as a trainer in August 2021. Since then, my journey has been full of learning and growth. With support from Godrej Salon-i, I received structured training, worked on curriculum development, and organized exposure visits. Every day brings new challenges, but even more satisfaction.

Today, we’ve expanded our mission. To enhance employability, we’ve introduced Advanced Courses for those wanting to upskill. I’m especially excited about our collaboration with the Ananda Spa Foundation, which offers specialized Spa and Wellness Services Training Programs, opening doors to premium placements nationwide. I am thankful to Sanjay Sir, Manoj Sir, and Vishnu Sir for their constant guidance and support. Poonam Ma’am has mentored me throughout, while Anuj Shukla Sir has always motivated me. Ram Sir played a vital role in my personal and professional development. And my heartfelt thanks to the entire Gurukul team, who helped me adapt to a professional work environment and continue to inspire me every day.

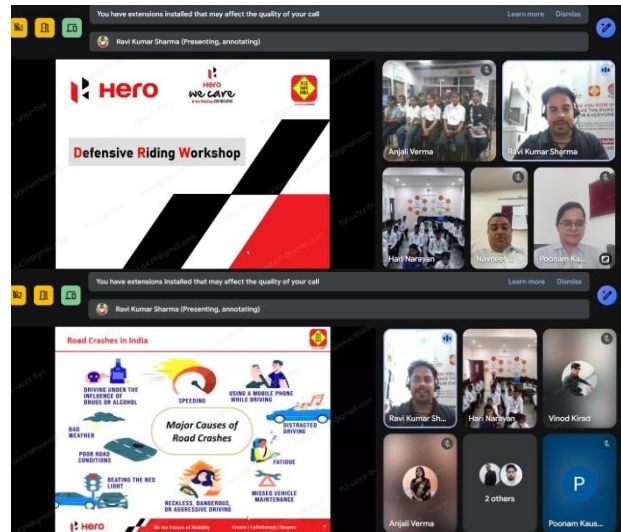

INDUSTRY EXPERT'S SESSIONS

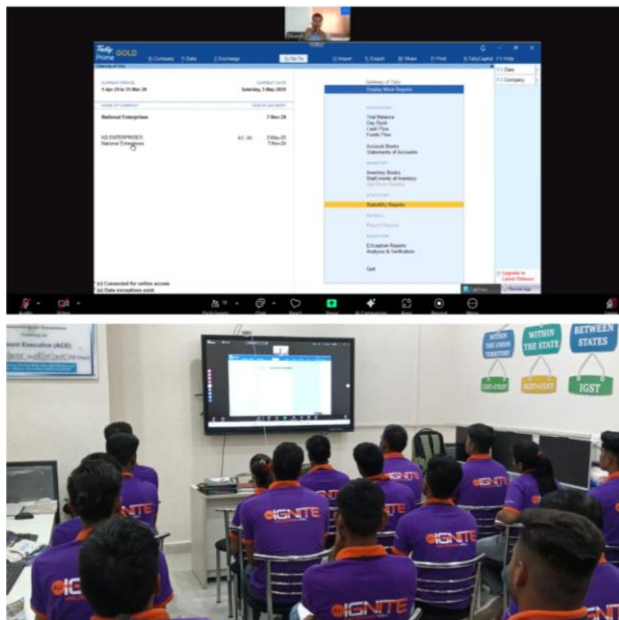
Virtual Session on Defensive Riding | 13 May, 2025

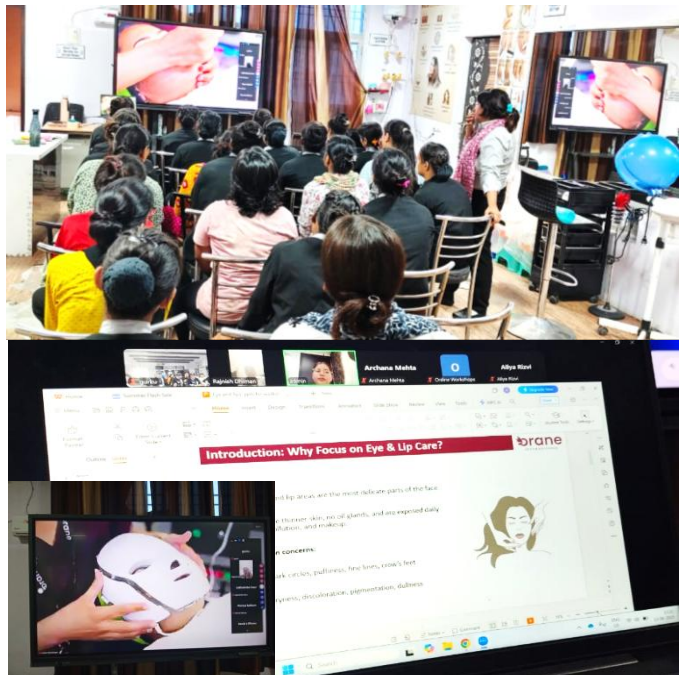

Virtual Session on Lip & Eye Care | 13 June, 2025

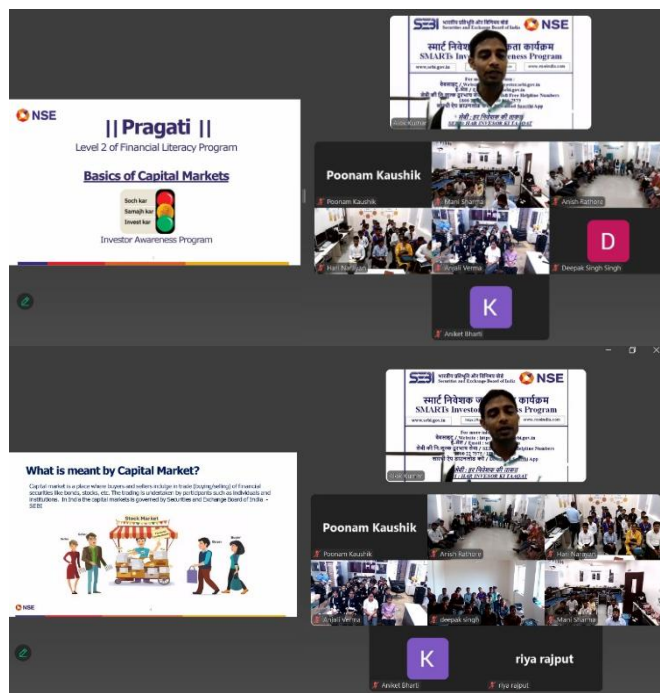
