# Krishnashray Gurukul Celebrates its First-Ever International Placements in Dubai

We are proud to share that **Mr. Vishnu** and **Mr. Saurabh**, students of *Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI*, have become the **first trainees from Gurukul to secure international placements in Dubai**.

## Background of Students

- **Vishnu** belongs to a lower middle-class family from *Mehmadpur village, Bharatpur District, Rajasthan*. He completed his Graduation in Arts in 2022 and spent two years preparing for government examinations but could not succeed.
- **Saurabh** also comes from a lower middle-class family from *Gunsara village, Bharatpur District, Rajasthan*. He completed his Graduation in Arts in 2020 and similarly spent nearly four years preparing for competitive exams without success.



Due to lack of practical skills, both were unable to secure stable private jobs and were facing uncertainty in their career paths.

## Training at Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI

In August 2024, both joined Gurukul's **Account Assistant training program**. Around the same time, Gurukul launched a **special initiative for graduate students** – additional training in *Equity Derivatives (NISM Series VIII)*. Despite being Arts graduates, both Vishnu and Saurabh showed great interest and enrolled in this advanced training.

From **September to November 2024**, they successfully completed the program and cleared the **NISM Equity Derivative Series VIII certification** in their very first attempt.

## First Placement in India

Post certification, both were placed in **January 2025** with *Junomoneta Finsol Pvt. Ltd., Delhi* as **Assistant Research Analysts**, with a starting salary of **₹32,000 per month**.

## Overseas Opportunity

In July 2025, Gurukul introduced a new overseas placement opportunity for students trained in equity derivatives. Both Vishnu and Saurabh, aspiring to work abroad, applied for the same. After successfully clearing the interview process, they were selected by **Bellerophon DMCC, Dubai**.

## Job Role in Dubai

- **Designation:** Trader
- **Key Responsibilities:** Handling orders in the securities market, maintaining internal databases, and assisting in accounting procedures.
- **Probation Salary:** 2000 AED (approx. ₹60,000 per month)
- **Post-Probation Salary:** 2500 AED (approx. ₹65,000 per month)
- **Additional Benefits:** Free, fully furnished company accommodation.

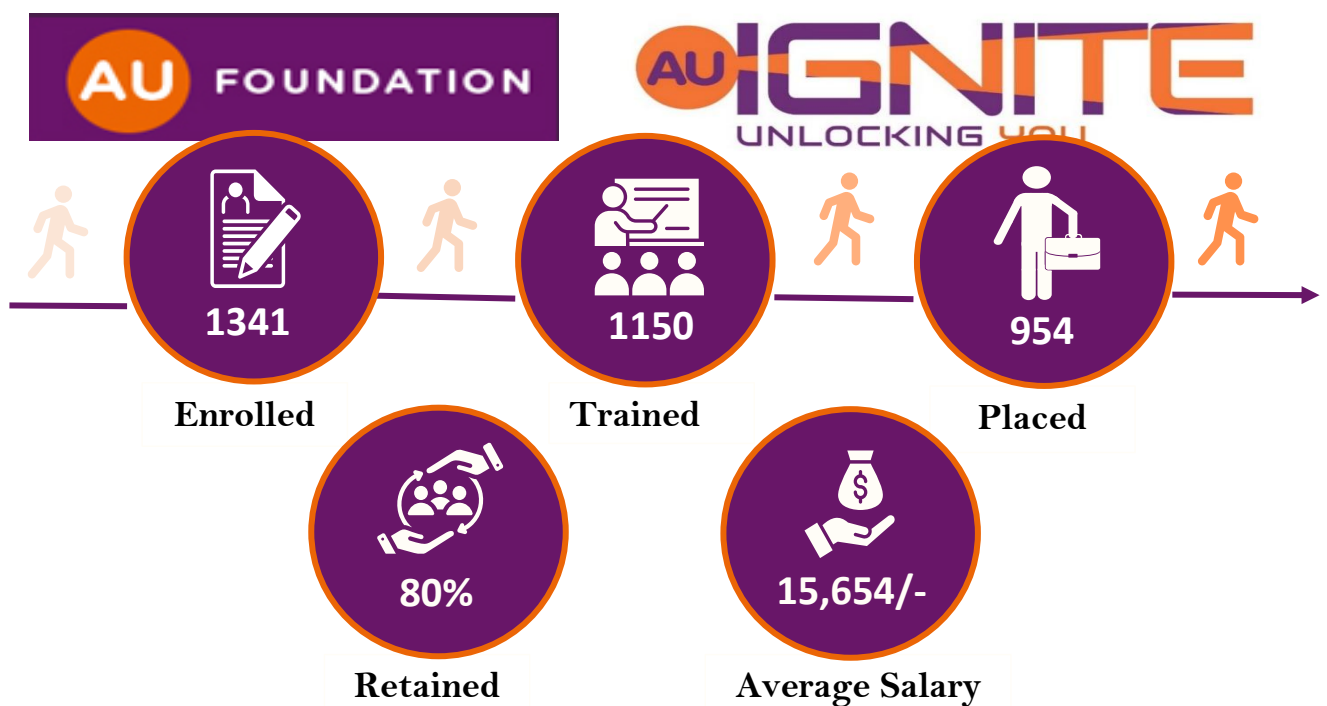

## Sustainable Energy Milestone: 45 KW Solar Installation at Gurukul

Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI has completed the installation of a **45 KW on-grid solar power system**, marking an important step towards sustainability and energy efficiency on campus. The system consists of **87 solar plates**, each with a capacity of **590 watts**, and is supported by **two SolarEdge inverters** (33.3 KW and 10 KW). Together, this setup will generate approximately **51,000–57,000 units of electricity every year**, meeting the majority of Gurukul’s electricity needs.

The green benefits are equally inspiring:

- **24–25 tons of carbon emissions reduced annually**
- **Equivalent to saving nearly 1,100 trees through plantation green belt efforts**

By harnessing renewable energy, Gurukul not only lowers its carbon footprint but also demonstrates how **skill development and sustainability can go hand-in-hand** — setting an example for our trainees and the wider community.

# PROGRESS UNDER BETTER WHEAT INITIATIVE

## Hariyalo Rajasthan – Plantation Drive | Jul-25

As part of the **Better Wheat Initiative**, a large-scale tree plantation drive was organized from **July 10 to July 27, 2025**, across multiple locations. Over the course of this campaign, **100 saplings were planted**, reinforcing our commitment to environmental conservation, community engagement, and sustainable rural development.

The plantation drive was thoughtfully designed around **different themes**, each highlighting a unique aspect of social and environmental responsibility:

- **Guru Purnima**: Saplings were planted at **Kanchanpura Primary School** to honor the invaluable role of teachers in shaping young lives.
- **“Har Paudha, Sehat ka Vada”**: Plants were placed at **Anganwadi centers, health centers, and hospitals**, symbolizing the strong link between a healthy environment and community well-being.
- **“Harit Kranti”**: Trees were planted near **common village lands and water bodies** to promote water conservation and strengthen the ecosystem around shared resources.
- **“Sansthatgat Hariyali”**: At the **Krishnashray SEDI campus**, saplings were added to encourage institutional greenery and to inspire students to value sustainability.
- **“Harit Path”**: Along **farm boundaries**, plantations were carried out to improve soil health, create shade, and contribute to safer, greener surroundings for farmers.
- **“Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam”**: Community members planted trees **in memory of their mothers**, turning the drive into an emotional and collective tribute that connected environmental care with deep personal values.

## KVK Mathura Exposure Visit & PM-Kisan Samman Nidhi Program 02 Aug 2025

Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI facilitated farmer participation in the **PM-Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana – 20th installment release program**, where Hon'ble Prime Minister **Shri Narendra Modi** virtually addressed farmers across the country.

At the Goverdhan center, the event was graced by **Shri Chaudhary Laxminarayan (Sugarcane Minister)** and **Shri Puran Prakash (MLA)** as chief guests. The program included meaningful interactions with farmers on various **government schemes**, discussions on **crop damage caused by heavy rainfall and waterlogging**, and instructions to officials for **timely crop loss assessments**.

A total of **35 farmers from Sakarwa and Kanchanpura villages** actively participated in the event. ## Learning the Future of Finance at Gurukul | 05 July, 2025

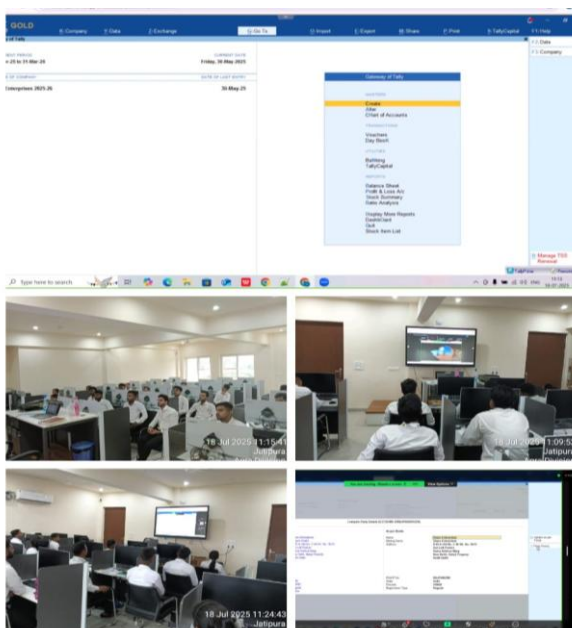

## Teacher's Day Celebration | 05 Sep, 2025

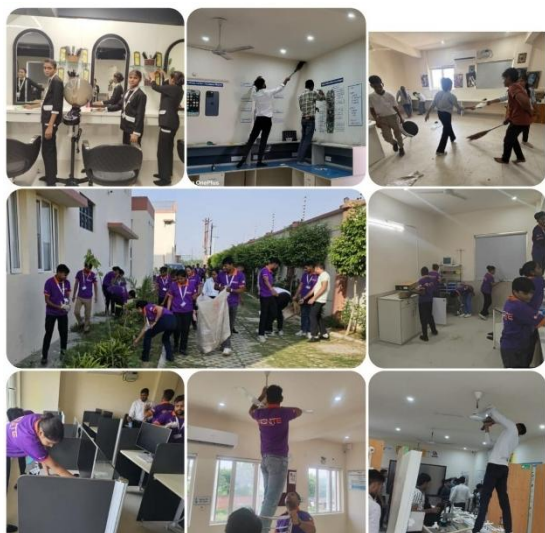

At Gurukul, we believe that **cleanliness is service**, and this activity served as a reminder to keep our campus clean, beautiful, and inspiring for all.

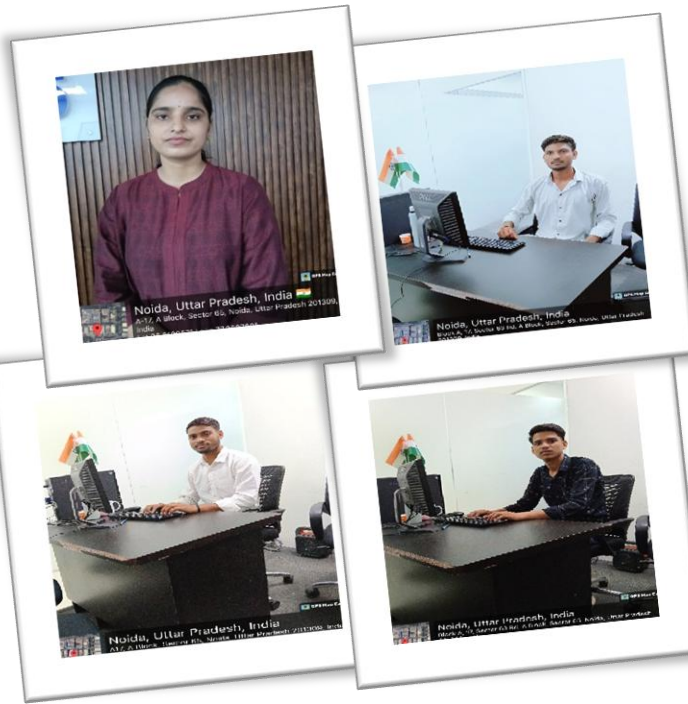

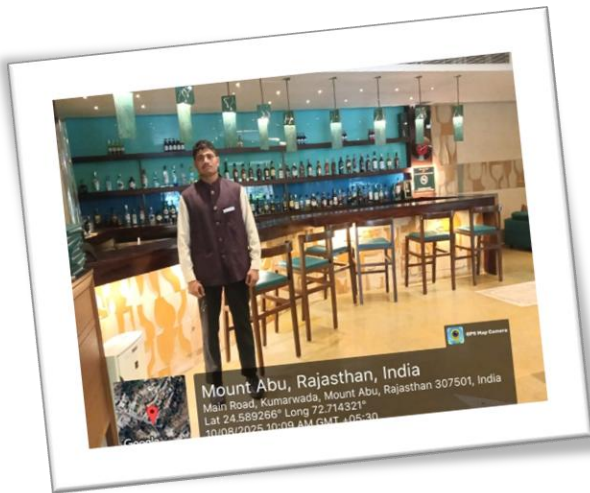
