PROGRESS UNDER DIXON CSR PROGRAM



Dixon partnered with **Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI** starting in **FY 2023-24**, funding **toolkits** for the **Mobile Phone Hardware Repair Technician** batch. This support enabled hands-on training for candidates, aligning with SEDI's mission to deliver practical skill development programs.

In **FY 2024-25**, Dixon continued the collaboration by funding the **Handset Repair Engineer** batch, building on prior success. For **FY 2025-26**, they extended funding to both **Assistant Electrician** and **Handset Repair Engineer** batches, ensuring sustained access to essential resources.



This long-term partnership shows Dixon's commitment to helping rural youth through its CSR efforts. Dixon supports skill training programs that improve job opportunities and create better livelihoods.

By setting up practical training facilities, the company is helping rural communities grow and enabling young people to become financially independent.

From FY 2024-25 till date, the program has delivered measurable impact in youth skilling and workforce readiness, enrolling 227 candidates and **successfully training 197 participants** through structured vocational interventions. These efforts resulted in **143 placements across both wage employment and self-employment**, achieving a 77% placement success rate. Notably, **100 beneficiaries have sustained their livelihoods**, with an average **monthly earning of ₹15,039**, underscoring the program's effectiveness in creating stable employment and entrepreneurial pathways.

TEAMS' CORNER



My name is Mani Sharma, and I come from a humble family in Moradabad. Though I completed my Master's in Arts, my heart had always been drawn towards electronics. Since the age of sixteen, repairing gadgets brought me a sense of joy and curiosity that academics never could. **My father**, who is no longer with us, had an **extraordinary talent for electronics**—even without any formal training. Watching him work left a deep impression on me. His passion became my inspiration, and I decided to follow the same path. With limited resources but strong determination, I enrolled in a six-month Mobile & Laptop Repairing course at the Hitech Institute in Moradabad. That training helped me discover what truly excited me. I knew then that this was the field where I wanted to build my future.

My professional journey began in 2011 when I received my first opportunity as a Mobile Repairing Trainer at Istep Intravo, Bijnor (UP). That one year shaped the foundation of my skills. After that, I worked locally for nearly four years, repairing mobiles and electronics. Those years were crucial — I learned how to speak to customers, understand their needs, and handle responsibilities independently. In 2017, life came full circle when I again received the chance to work as a trainer at PMKK (Empower Pragati), Amroha. Training students had always given me satisfaction, and returning to that role felt right. During this period, I was also certified by the **Telecom Sector Skill Council and completed TOT (Training of Trainers) and TOA (Training of Assessors)**. I also received training from NIESBUD in Entrepreneurship Development.

Then came 2020—a year of uncertainty for the entire world. It was just after the first wave of COVID when I received a call from Ambuja Foundation for the role of Mobile Repairing Trainer at Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI, Goverdhan. I was hesitant at first due to the pandemic, but something in my heart pushed me to say yes—perhaps it was Giriraj ji's blessing, or the excitement of working in a place like Goverdhan. **I joined Gurukul on 10 October 2020**. What I saw on the first day surprised me: small classrooms, minimal setup, and a newly launched course without any precedent to follow. I was the first trainer for the program, responsible for setting up the lab, preparing training material, and mobilizing youth. It was challenging—but even more rewarding. To build something from scratch, to watch it grow, and to know you played a part in its foundation that is a rare privilege. Every single day since 10 October 2020 has taught me something new.

I have witnessed Gurukul grow from a small centre to a vibrant institution with multiple training verticals. During these years, I also received tremendous opportunities for my own development—training at **Guru School, Pune for platform skills, SUPER30 sessions for spoken English**, and now **Geeta ji's sessions which have enriched me at a personal and spiritual level**. What makes Gurukul truly special is that it never treats us like employees. **We are treated like family. Every person is valued. Growth here is not just professional—it is holistic, touching every part of who we are.**

I am deeply grateful to **Shri Sanjay Kothari Sir**. His vision and guidance are not just motivating—they are transformative. His words have shaped my approach to work and life. I also want to express heartfelt gratitude to my entire Gurukul team. We have seen ups and downs, but what remained constant was our team bonding, learning, and happiness. Without this support system, this journey would not have been half as meaningful. Most importantly, I bow my head to Giriraj Ji. Without His blessings, I would not be where I am today.

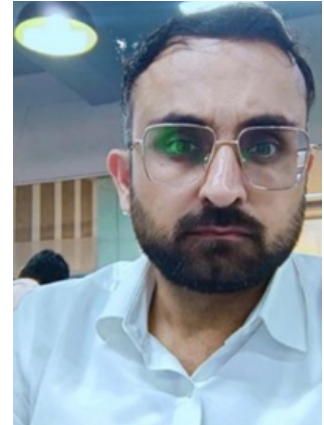

Krishnashray Gurukul SEDI welcomes Mr. Abhishek Tomar as Documentation Officer

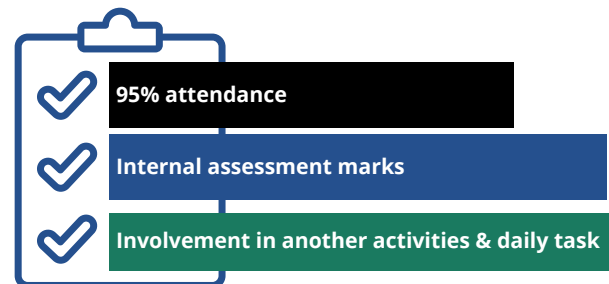

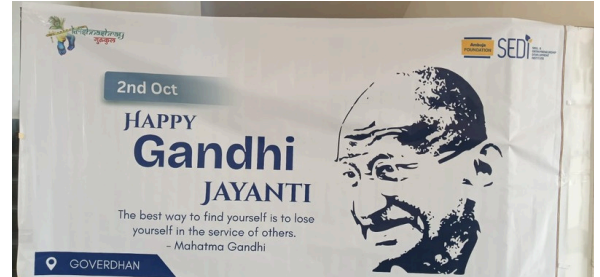

A frontline demonstration on 46 one-acre farmer fields showcased improved wheat varieties SR 303 and HD 2967, promoting scientific practices like balanced nutrients, timely line sowing, seed treatment, residue management, and need-based plant protection. The initiative aims to achieve uniform crop growth, better tillering, higher biomass, and stronger ear head development, driving adoption of improved varieties, better grain and fodder quality, and sustainable productivity.

Under the Better Wheat Initiative, a farmer training program built technical skills and promoted scientific, sustainable agriculture. It covered ICM, vegetable cultivation, IPM/IDM, INM, soil health, and micro-irrigation, encouraged wheat demos with DBW 303 and HD 2967, and distributed PoP to support improved wheat management.

Under the “Enhancing Farm Productivity Through Integrated Nutrient Management (INM)” intervention, input kits were provided to farmers to improve crop yield, quality, and overall soil health by promoting balanced, efficient, and sustainable nutrient use. The support included Zinc Sulphate, Sagarika, and Consortia, which were distributed to strengthen nutrient availability and enhance wheat crop productivity.
